Course Description:

Analysis of variance and covariance; chi square tests; nonparametric procedures multiple and curvilinear regression; experimental design and power of tests. Application to biological problems. Use of computer programs in standard statistical problems.

The Predoctoral Instructor (PDI) will have full responsibility for teaching the course, including all lectures, virtual field trips, assignments, exams, grading, creating make-up assignments, and answering student questions.

Graduate student applicants must be making satisfactory academic progress.

Salary:

Salaried ASE positions are 60% FTE (24 hrs/week). Predoctoral Instructor appointments pay graduate students at the Candidate rank, which is \$3,949/mo in AY 2024-25.
