 - Talk to them about keeping the WAC and surrounding areas neat and tidy.
- Isaiah suggested adding a map to the end of our Policies document to show our sailing boundaries
 - Most opinions were that this could definitely be a good addition.
 - We should see whether the upcoming work around the 520 Bridge will impact the club.
- Clearing out other items in the Shell House
 - There are a lot of dinghy parts in the Shell House that haven't been used recently.
 - There is a RIB, Flying Scot centerboard, masts, etc. that don't seem to be in use right now.
 - Use your best judgment and clear it out. Organize a few more work parties and keep in mind that there is a lot of equipment in there that we don't need anymore. Also keep in mind that we will lose that space eventually.
 - Taking pictures of the items and distributing them may be the best way to figure out what everything is.
- Apoorva asked if we plan to get social sailing going again?
 - Dylan: Yes, likely on the weekends due to early sunsets in the winter. If anybody wants to have an activity, let Dylan know and we can get it on the books.
 - Dylan got his Food Handler's Permit, which is an easy process. Some other club members also have one.
- General comment: It's good to have regular meetings and see the club active again.
